In the early 1970s, on a few occasions, Dorothy and her husband vacationed in Utah. Visiting their son and other family members, they fell in love with the state. In 1974, they made the move to Utah with their sons. They have thoroughly enjoyed living here. They have spent time in the mountains, gone fishing, camping and hunting. They also enjoyed the occasional trip to Wendover. They watched their family grow and were blessed with seven grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren. Dorothy loves visiting with her family, sharing stories of old traditions and making new memories and traditions to pass on.
