And may all your Christmases be white*

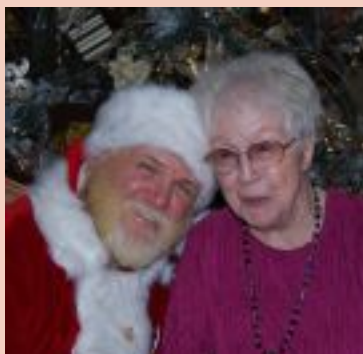
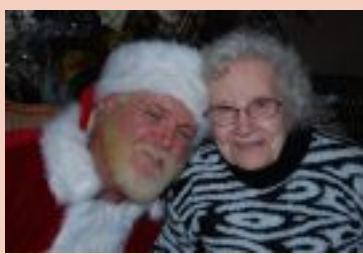

They made their home in Granger and were married for 62 years when he passed away this past April. Together they have two boys and three girls, 14 grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren. They also raised a foster daughter. In August 1961, tragedy struck their family and their 7-year-old son drowned at Lagoon. Joan loves to travel and go anywhere for a ride in the car—especially to enjoy the fall leaves. She especially likes decorating her home for each holiday. Every year for Halloween, Joan would dress up as a witch and hand out candy to trick-or-treaters. She had the best “witch cackle” around! Joan has always appreciated the friendship of her neighborhood friends and has been going to lunch with them on a regular basis for over 50 years.
