Emelia and Connell Roberts



Connell was originally from Ogden and Emelia was raised in Cardston, Alberta. They both had honest hardworking parents who loved the Gospel. They met at BYU. Connell had previously spent three years in the military in World War II. When Connell returned home from the service, he was called on a mission to New Zealand. After his mission, he went to Provo to see about going to BYU. Emelia had filled a mission in California and was now attending BYU, working in the Veterans Office, so she was the first girl he met. They both enjoyed BYU and were married in 1950. Connell especially enjoyed being Branch President of the singles branch for two years. After Connell received his Master's in Chemistry from BYU and Emelia graduated with a degree in Foods and Nutrition, they went to the University of CA at Berkley

where he completed his EdD in Education Administration. Connell began teaching Chemistry at Sacramento City College and then was Associate Dean of Instruction. Later, he became Dean of Instruction at a large community college in San Bernardino, CA. While in Sacramento, he became President of the California Teachers Association, Northern Section, representing 13,000 teachers.

The Church has always been a top priority in their lives and they have had much joy in service. For awhile, Connell taught early morning Seminary and the first Institute classes in Sacramento.

The Roberts say the best thing that they have done is have their seven children. They have been a joy in their lives and kept them very busy. There were times they had several children attending BYU at the same time. It helped when their eldest daughter was chosen the most outstanding freshman girl for the year and received a scholarship for the remaining three years.

After Connell retired, they served a mission to Scotland. Upon returning, they moved to Orem where they participated in some of the BYU activities. Mostly, they enjoyed having the children stay with them when they came to bring their children to BYU or Education Week. The Roberts now have 35 grandchildren.

They have always enjoyed gardening, but after 14 years of caring for gardens and yards while Connell was Stake Patriarch, it became too much.
