1633: Physicist and astronomer Galileo Galilei is convicted of heresy.

1719: "Robinson Crusoe," by Daniel Defoe, is published. The book, about a shipwrecked sailor who spends 28 years on a remote island, has been popular ever since.

1742: In Dublin, Handel's "Messiah" debuts.

1792: George Washington exercises the first presidential veto.

1841: Edgar Allen Poe's "The Murders in the Rue Morgue" is published. The work is considered the first detective story.

1865: President Abraham Lincoln is shot by John Wilkes Booth.

1887: Susanna Madora Salter, the first female mayor in the country, is elected in Argonia, Kan.

1895: Writer Oscar Wilde is arrested in London.

1930: With what was then a banana cream filling, Twinkies appeared on the market.

1948: The World Health Organization is established.

1954: Sen. Joseph McCarthy begins hearings accusing the Army of communist sympathies.

1961: Judy Garland performs at Carnegie Hall.

1963: On the same day, April 1, "General Hospital" premieres on the ABC television network and "The Doctors" premieres on rival network NBC.

1964: Sidney Poitier receives the Best Actor Oscar for "Lilies of the Field."

2008: Danica Patrick becomes the first woman to win an IndyCar race.

2011: British Prince William weds Kate Middleton, an event celebrated around the world.
