## Resident Spotlight - Jens Jacobsen



Jens was born on May 20 in Ogden, UT. His ancestors came from Denmark and crossed the plains with Mormon pioneers. He moved to Honolulu, Hawaii, when 3 years old as his father had a business opportunity. As a young man, Jens was a colonel in the ROTC program in high school and loved it. Jens met his wife, Jean, on a blind date set up by friends. He proposed on Valentine's Day and married on June 23, 1945, in Honolulu. Jens was at church helping the bishop when Japanese bombers flew over Pearl Harbor. He worked at the phone company during the war to help with communications. He has worked in the Pineapple Cannery, Hawaiian Telephone Company, Oahu Sugar Co., Meadow Gold Dairy, and assorted other sales positions. He was a good salesman, very dedicated to his clients, friendly and helpful. Jean and Jens were sealed in the Logan temple in 1947. He converted his wife to the gospel while they lived there for one year. They then moved back to Hawaii and had been there ever since.

Jens has served in the LDS church as bishop and high councilor for many years. Beloved and respected by friends and church members in Hawaii for his kind ways, giving heart, and selfless service. Jens enjoys sports, especially football (which his sons played and he enthusiastically supported). He moonlighted as a basketball referee for many years. Jens was also a skilled swimmer and competed in church stake swim meets even into his later years. He also learned to play the ukulele after retiring. Jens really enjoys ethnic food in Hawaii and loves to eat! Jean, his wife of 64 years, passed away suddenly in January 2009. He then moved to Georgia to live with his daughter. Then in 2012 Jens came to join us at Carrington Court. Jens has always been known as a gentleman and hard worker. He loved to dance and sing to his wife, Jean! His legacy includes 19 grandchildren and 13 great-grandchildren. Something unique to Jens that no other Carrington Court resident can say, he was baptized in the ocean and lived in Hawaii for 85 years!
