"This Month In History" JULY

1814: The poet Percy Shelley and "Frankenstein" author Mary Wollstonecraft Godwin elope to France.

1817: Construction begins on the Erie Canal, which connects the Great Lakes and Atlantic Ocean.

1848: The first women's rights convention in the United States is held in Seneca Falls, N.Y. Activists Lucretia Mott and Elizabeth Cady Stanton organize the event.

1914: Star pitcher and legendary hitter Babe Ruth takes the field at Fenway Park and leads the Boston Red Sox to victory in his first MLB game.

1928: The first sliced bread from a sliced bread machine is sold. The sale occurs in Chillicothe, Mo.

1937: Beginning a mystery that has fascinated many for decades, Amelia Earhart's plane disappears. Onboard are Earhart and her navigator, Fred Noonan.

1941: The Enigma Key, a difficult code used by the German army, is broken by cryptologists in Britain.

1957: The Beatles' John Lennon and Paul McCartney meet for the first time.

1972: "Lean on Me" by Bill Withers rises to the top of the charts for the first time. It would do so again 15 years later.

1984: The right hand to presidential nominee Walter Mondale, Geraldine Ferraro is chosen as the first woman vice presidential candidate on a major party ticket.

1997: The restored USS Constitution ("Old Ironsides") sails again after 116 years.

2008: The Batman movie "The Dark Knight" has the highest-grossing weekend in film history at the time.
