"This Month In History" JUNE

1613: The Globe Theatre, where most of Shakespeare's plays debuted, burns down. The fire starts when a cannon is fired during a performance of "Henry VIII."

1777: Congress officially adopts the Stars and Stripes flag with 13 stars and 13 stripes.

1884: "The Switchback Railway" roller coaster opens at Coney Island in Brooklyn, N.Y. A ride costs 5 cents.

1896: Henry Ford completes his first automobile, which he calls a Quadricycle.

1919: The 19th Amendment, which gives women the right to vote, is passed by Congress.

1922: The Newbery Medal debuts. The medal is given to honor the most distinguished American children's book of the year.

1933: The first drive-in movie theater opens in New Jersey.

1942: Anne Frank receives a diary for her 13th birthday. In it, she famously chronicles her experiences as a Jewish girl in the midst of World War II.

1966: The Miranda v. Arizona Supreme Court decision leads to the establishment of the Miranda warning, and suspects of crimes must now be told their rights before being questioned.

1980: CNN (Cable News Network), the first 24-hour news network, debuts.

1983: Sally Ride becomes the first American woman in space with a six-day mission on the Challenger space shuttle.

2006: "Cars" is released. The movie wins the first Golden Globe Award for Best Animated Feature Film.
