# "This Month In History" october

1781: British General Charles Cornwallis formally surrenders, putting an end to the fighting of the American Revolutionary War.

**1810:** The first Oktoberfest is held in Munich, Bavaria, Germany.

**1854:** Oscar Wilde is born in Dublin, Ireland. He goes on to write many poems, plays and one novel, many of which are still popular today.

**1892:** Sir Arthur Conan Doyle's "The Adventures of Sherlock Holmes" is published.

**1904:** The New York subway opens, marking a new way to get around the city.

**1931:** Gangster Al Capone, one of the most notorious criminals of his time, is sent to prison.

**1941:** Mount Rushmore, the sculpture of four presidents carved into a mountain, is completed after 14 years of work.

**1947:** Harry Truman delivers the first televised presidential address. His topic is food conservation.

**1962:** Johnny Carson takes over for Jack Paar as the host of "The Tonight Show."

1965: The Gateway Arch in Saint Louis, Mo., is completed. The Arch symbolizes the city's nickname of "Gateway to the West."

1973: The Sydney Opera House opens after 15 years in the making. The Opera House is now the most easily recognizable feature of Sydney, Australia.

1998: John Glenn launches into orbit aboard the space shuttle Discovery, nearly 40 years after becoming the first American to orbit Earth.

**2007:** Al Gore and his associates win the Nobel Peace Prize for their work involving climate change, including the film "An Inconvenient Truth."
